

MY NIGHT IN A BOX - FAQ

The best way of thinking of My Night in a Box is as a sleepover with a purpose. My Night in a Box is an overnight discipleship experience for local church student ministries to teach, engage, and motivate each other to get involved with their local rescue ministry – while hosting a simple fund raiser for their local rescue mission.

The model is simple. Take for example a small church group of ten students. These ten kids would recruit ten sponsors each at \$10 to sponsor their night in a box. Upon Friday afternoon arrival at their church students serve a Rescue meal, receive Biblical teaching, spend the night outdoors in a box, scavenger hunt for supper, and do a Saturday park cleanup and prayer walk.

The goal is that students have a weekend of transformation through experience – or learning by doing. We are excited to give this back to AGRM missions for free. It is a simple electronic document that in .doc or .PDF format. Most groups desiring to customize My Night with their logo will want to use the .doc file.

What is it?

An overnight experience to help church groups learn about homelessness, raise financial support, volunteer in a rescue ministry, and perform a community give-back in a safe, fun environment.

Why “My Night?”

Churches are always in need of creative, practical ways to teach and lead students to make a difference. Rescue Missions in turn, need to gain support, socially engage a new generation, and continue to help the poor.

How Does “My Night” Work in the Community?

My Night engages each student to recruit ten sponsors who will each give \$10 to sponsor their own “night in a box.” That’s each student raising \$100 to address the needs of the homeless, and gives the mission an opportunity to connect their information with 10 new donors.

Is it really free?

Yes. Western Carolina Rescue Ministries put together “My Night” to help teach the students of Western North Carolina and give them an easy way to support the needs of their clients. We realized that lots of Rescue Missions could use this tool, so we are glad to place our efforts in your hands for you to use to generate grass roots support and awareness for your ministry.
