## **Christ-Centered**

We strive to provide an opportunity for a changed life through the experience and greater understanding of personal faith. Focusing on whole-person health, we introduce healthy lifestyles and building supportive relationships through full days spent in youth activities such as chapel, Bible memory, crafts, camping, canoeing, fishing, hiking, sports, group games archery, and swimming.

# Founded in 1935

Camp CUMCITO (City Union Mission Camp in the Ozarks) offers a one-week summer Bible camp experience for low-income youth from urban Kansas City and rural Benton County. Sitting on 600 acres near Warsaw, MO, approximately 600 youth between the ages of 4-16 participated in summer camp each year. Camp is made possible each year by the generous volunteers who staff over 400 positions, and donors who contribute over \$380 per camper. Most campers only pay a \$5 registration fee.

## **Volunteer Details**

Most positions are staffed by volunteers

- The only way we can provide camp for youth is by staffing positions each week with volunteers.
- See "Adopt a Week".

Volunteers must be Christians actively growing in their spiritual development and regular in their participation in an evangelical Christian church.

- Screening process includes an application, references, and interview. Training is required for all positions.
- Volunteer staff must stay on campus during their work week.
- Volunteer staff are given 2 hours off per day to leave campus.
- Minimum age requirements:
  - 16 years old: Assistant positions at Big Camp and Big Siblings at Tot Lot
  - 18 years old: Leader positions
  - 21 years old: Supervisor positions

## **Adopt a Week**

Adopting a week entails recruiting a group of volunteer staff from church to fill available camp positions, and assisting your volunteers with registration and training.

Benefits include:

- Learning about different cultures.
- Camp training is applicable to church ministry.
- Great opportunity to minister side-by-side and foster teamwork.
- Campers can see and experience God's love as they experience your team live out His command for us to love one another.
- Opportunity for your volunteer team and church to be prayer warriors for campers and each other.
- Families work together and have the opportunity to build unity and leadership qualities together.
- A chance for members to get to know each other and build new relationships.
